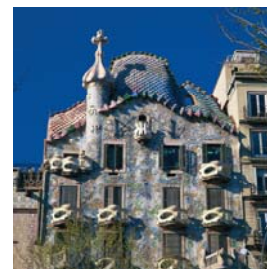

1) LEGAL REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO THE COMBINED TRIP AGREEMENT

These General Conditions are subject to the provisions of Law 21/1995, of 6 July, on Combined Trips (BOE 7-7-1995), Law 7/1998, of 13 April, on General Contracting Conditions (14- 4-98) and the General Consumer and User Protection Act 26/1984, of 19 July, (BOE 24-7- 84), and other current provisions.

2) ORGANIZATION

This combined trip has been organized by VISITSPAIN S.L., V.A.T. (CIF) N° B-83207795, with address at Avenida Manoteras, 38 Bloque B, Oficina 306, 28050 Madrid. Licence title C.I.C.M.A. – 1419.

3) COMBINED TRIPS

For the purpose of the regulations governing these general conditions, a combined trip shall be one combining at least two of the following items:

- a) transport
- b) accommodation
- c) other tourist services not ancillary to the previous two.

4) PRICE

4.1.) The price of the Combined Trip includes:

- 1) Return transport, when this service is included in the programme, with the corresponding type of transport, features and category,, although the times may undergo variation after the publication of the programme/brochure.
- 2) When this service is included in the programme, accommodation at the establishment with the corresponding meals service, although the times of occupancy will depend on the rules of each hotel.
- 3) The hotel establishment taxes or duties and indirect taxes.
- 4) Technical assistance during the trip, when specifically included.
- 5) All the other services and supplements specified in the programme.

4.2.) Price review

The price is calculated on the basis of the exchange rates, transport rates and taxes applicable at the time of publication of the programme. Due to the fact that the brochure is issued well in advance, some taxes or rates may undergo variation during its period of validity. However, although we reserve the right to change the price in an appropriate proportion, all those booking made prior to any change in rates are guaranteed against any increase once they have been confirmed.

5) METHOD OF PAYMENT.

A deposit may be requested at the time of booking, although this will never be more than 40% of the total amount of the trip. The remaining amount should be paid at delivery of the trip documentation.

6) CANCELLATIONS

Clients may withdraw from the services requested or contracted at any time, with entitlement to the refund of the amounts that they may have paid, although the agency should be compensated for the items listed below:

- 1) In the case of separate services, the whole of the arrangement costs, plus cancellation costs, if applicable.
- 2) In the event of cancellation of a combined trip, the Agency should be compensated for the items stated below:
 - a) Arrangement expenses, plus the respective cancellation costs, if any.
 - b) Penalty consisting of 5% of the total cost of the trip if the cancellation takes place more than ten but less than fifteen days before the departure date, 15% between 3 and 10 days, and 25% within forty-eight hours of departure.

7) ALTERATIONS.

There shall be no compensation obligation when this is due to force majeure grounds, considering these to be unusual and unforeseeable circumstances beyond the interested party's control, which have consequences that could not be avoided despite his/her acting with all due diligence.

8) VALIDITY

This programme/brochure shall remain valid from 01 January 2010 to 30 December 2010.
